In a proud moment for the education community of Punjab, *The New Cambridge International public School, Derabassi*, has emerged as a beacon of academic excellence in the SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning) 2024-25 – a competency-based assessment conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Despite being a relatively young and growing institution located in the semi-urban belt of Derabassi, the school has outperformed national, regional, and district averages across multiple subjects and grades, reflecting its unwavering focus on quality, conceptual learning, and holistic development.

Achievement Highlights:

- **Grade 5 Language**: 45% of students secured placement in the *Advanced* proficiency category (National Avg: 17%).
- **Grade 5 Mathematics**: 39% of learners attained *Advanced* proficiency levels (National Avg: 10%).
- **Grade 5 EVS**: School average score stood at an impressive **353.34**, significantly above the National Average of 297.
- **Grade 8 Mathematics**: School average of **348.72**, with strong conceptual clarity and problem-solving skills on display.
- **Grade 8 Science**: 34% of students reached *Advanced* proficiency, highlighting strong foundations in scientific inquiry and reasoning.
- **Grade 8 Language**: Students demonstrated strong analytical and reading comprehension abilities, especially in narrative interpretation and vocabulary usage.

These outstanding outcomes are a reflection of the school's progressive pedagogy, a techintegrated learning environment, and a dedicated teaching community that believes in nurturing each child's potential.
